Assessment Procedure for Sports Scholarship

Assessments are held in the Autumn and Spring terms during Year 6. Year 7 pupils are observed for sporting potential during Physical Education lessons.

Assessments last for approximately 2 hours during which time each child will work alongside other candidates on a variety of sport related tasks.

Assessment activities are organised by the Head of Sport, Health and Recreation with appropriate staff and coaches present at all sessions.

Given the wide range of sporting experiences and skills that many candidates bring to assessment sessions our programme is not always specific to any one sport, but carefully designed to evaluate the key components required for particular sporting activities.

Activity 1: Coached activity and drills evaluating response to coaching for sporting potential, motivation and application of skills.

Activity 2: Individual and group activities measuring hand-eye co-ordination, reaction time, speed, concentration, listening skills, working within a team.

Activity 3: Fitness test measuring stamina, motivation and application.
